Ministry: Worship

Pipeline Level: Team Member

Reports To: Media Coordinator

Purpose Statement: The Audio Team Member, along with the entire worship team, facilitates and leads the congregation in the worship experience by creating a clear and balanced mix. This position specifically mixes for our online viewers, helping to bring the best experience from our live setting to their devices.

Responsibilities:

- Arrive prior to worship service to check and set-up equipment as needed (check in with Media Team and Audio Team, trouble shoot equipment, minor equipment repair, etc.)
- Operate sound equipment during all services and special events. This includes mixing sound, recording message and music, communicating via coms with Media Team, etc.
- Confirm or decline your availability via Planning Center. If you decline, you need to find a replacement and notify the Team Leader and Media Coordinator. If you are unable to find a replacement, contact the Team Leader and Media Coordinator for assistance.

Time Investment:

- Day and time: Sundays 7:45 am – 11:30 pm; Wednesdays 6:15 – 8:30 pm (as needed); some Wednesdays; special events
- Length of service commitment: 1 year
- Anticipated time commitments:
 - Doing ministry/preparing for ministry: Sundays, up to 5 hours in the morning, Wednesday practices when scheduled
 - Participating in meetings/training: training is ongoing

Commitment:

- 1 year
- 3-month probationary period to see if it is the right fit

Prerequisites:

- A desire to mix broadcast sound and work with audio. Training and/or experience in operating sound equipment; love for music or experience playing an instrument.
- New growing Christian, 8th grade and older

Competency Training:

- Use of MXU online training provided by church
- Opportunities to attend other trainings when available.
