

Masterpiece Activity

This week we are learning that we are God's masterpiece! We'll dive into Genesis and learn about God's Creation. Of everything God created, we are His favorite masterpiece! For this activity, elementary students will only need to print out the "Masterpiece" sheet and follow along with the video. Parents of early childhood kids can lead their children in this activity by following the instructions below.

Early Childhood:

Supplies

- Bible
- "Masterpiece" handouts (below)
- Scissors
- Washable markers
- Yarn (optional)
- Glue (optional)

Instructions

- **Cut Out Figures**
 - Have kids fold their papers on the solid line
 - Cut out the figure along the dotted line, leaving it uncut at the fold
- **Decorate Figures**
 - On the front, they'll decorate their people to look like them. They can use markers for the face and clothes and cut yarn to glue on for hair.
 - Then have kids open up their paper people. On the inside of the card, have kids write words that describe who God made them on the inside. Help your kids with writing and spelling as needed
- **Read Ephesians 2:10**
 - *"We are God's creation. He created us to belong to Christ Jesus. Now we can do good works. Long ago God prepared these works for us to do.*
- **Ask:** What's something special God made you to be able to do?
- **Say:** We are God's masterpiece, inside and out. He made us so special, able to do good and important things for Him. Nothing about the way God made you is a mistake! He made you to look like the person you look like on the outside, *and* He made you with the personality, character, and skills you have on the inside. He made you [fill in words kids shared].
- **Pray, thanking God for how He made your family!**
