Ministry: Worship

Pipeline Level: Team Member

Reports To: Media Coordinator

Purpose Statement: The Media Team Member, along with the entire worship team, facilitates and leads the congregation in the worship experience by operating cameras, screens, lighting, and video switching for both the congregation and online experience.

Responsibilities:

- Arrive prior to worship services at the time assigned by the Media Coordinator.
- Operate media equipment during all services and special events. This includes camera, screens, lighting, video switching.
- Confirm or decline your availability via Planning Center. If you decline, you need to find a replacement and notify the Team Leader and Media Coordinator. If you are unable to find a replacement, contact the Team Leader and Media Coordinator for assistance.

Time Investment:

- Day and Time: Sundays 7 am – 12 pm; Some Wednesdays; special events
- Length of service commitment: 1 year
- Doing ministry/preparing for ministry: Sundays, up to 5 hours in the morning,
- Tech rehearsals when scheduled
- Participating in meetings/training: training is ongoing

Commitment:

- 1 year
- 3-month probationary period to see if it is the right fit

Prerequisites:

- A willingness to learn; familiarity with video camera, lighting, audio, computer skills helpful
- New growing Christian, 8th grade and older

Competency Training:

- Use of MXU online training provided by church
- Opportunities to attend other trainings when available
- Training is ongoing
